She is committed to helping children from the slum area of Sinamangal in Kathmandu who, for a variety of reasons, are not yet attending school. Maureen will be rewarded for her efforts with the laughter of the children and success, when the children make the step into public school.

Menschen im Dialog e.V. provided 5 Computers, 1 Projector and some teaching material. The teachers of the school were trained for five days to use the equipment for lessons and to carry out any necessary repair and maintenance work. With the help of the computers and learning software, students are enabled to learn and deepen the learned in a playful way, with the goal to increase the chance to succeed in school. Former pupils of the Milijuli-School can visit their former school after lessons and thus also take advantage of this additional learning opportunity.
